

## Afourer

Afourer originated from seed in Morocco from a 35-year-old Murcott tree in Afourer near Beni Mellal. The trees are reportedly precocious and high yielding setting crops without cross-pollination.

Fruit is 50 to 75mm in diameter has a deep orange-coloured, slightly pebbly rind. Fruit quality is reported to be high but few fruit have been seen in New Zealand so this variety is to be considered untried in New Zealand conditions. Conflicting reports on rootstock compatibility with some difficulties experienced with both Carrizo and Trifoliata.
