

Dweet

Dweet is a hybrid between Dancy tangerine and Mediterranean sweet orange bred in California. The fruit are medium-large, with a distinct neck and attractive rind colour. The flesh is very juicy with a perfumed aroma reminiscent of Earl Grey tea.

The rind peels quite cleanly, and segments separate well. The fruit have only three to four seeds each when not cross-pollinated. Dweet trees are vigorous and produce regular crops of evenly sized fruit with a short harvesting period of four weeks. Dweet has had limited success as a commercial variety in New Zealand.
